Drainage Works and Golf Course

Members are advised that Kempsey Shire Council have notified the Country Club that they plan to do Drainage Works from Monday 27 July 2020 onwards. These works are located on the western side of the 4th fairway and are adjacent to where Council will be installing new Cabins for the Caravan Park.

The works area is to be treated as "G.U.R.". Council are undertaking the work to mitigate water issues in the Caravan Park.

The work was initiated by Council, Council are responsible for the work and are bearing the cost of the project.

Country Club Greens Staff will assist Council as necessary.

We apologise for any inconvenience to golfers as we work collaboratively with Council and permit the drainage works to progress. We thank Council for the opportunity to allow us to notify members and guests prior to the Work being undertaken.
